HOTLAB

Objectives

- to assess the European Hot Laboratories research capacity
- and its aptitude for supporting the nuclear industry and research community
- ⇒taking a picture of present day situation
 - →PIE capabilities & research themes / occupancies
- ⇒as a basis towards future 'integration'
 - →transport issue as primary obstacle for cooperation



HOTLAB

- All deliverables delivered in due time
 - highly functional internet based catalogue of hot laboratories
 - →complemented by nuclear transport cask catalogue
 & first identification of transport operation needs
 - assessment of present occupation and future needs of experimental facilities



HOTLAB

But

- only a very useful 'format'
 - o catalogue format & functionalities adequate
 - →poor filling, hence limited benefit
 - o only first limited identification of transport issues
 - →not yet tackled
 - o research themes inventoried & individual labs occupancies
 - →not yet e.g. complementarities, cooperation modes, ...
- →due to limited resources
- ⇒formal (financed) resources needed in continuation project to realize HOTLAB's potential assets



HOTLAB closure

- delayed
 - due to heavy formal EU requirements
 - and great number
 - > + several inexperienced partners
- final approval FMR
 - obtained yesterday
 - final payment soon expected
